NC CPA BOARD ELECTS 2007-2008 OFFICERS

Raleigh, NC — On March 22, 2007, the members of the North Carolina State Board of Certified Public Accountant (CPA) Examiners elected officers for 2007-2008.

Arthur M. Winstead, Jr., CPA, of Greensboro, was elected President; Michael C. Jordan, CPA, of Goldsboro, was elected Vice President; and Jordan C. Harris, Jr., of Statesville, was elected Secretary-Treasurer.

Winstead, who previously served as the Board's Vice President and Secretary-Treasurer, is a member of the Executive Committee, the Professional Standards Committee, and the Audit Committee. He is a former member of the Professional Education and Applications Committee. Established by Chapter 93 of the North Carolina General Statutes, the North Carolina State Board of Certified Public Accountant Examiners is an occupational licensing board that grants certificates of qualification as certified public accountants (CPAs) to those individuals who meet the legal requirements. The Board also adopts and enforces the rules of professional ethics and conduct to be observed by CPAs in this State.

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
