Governor Easley Appoints Jeffrey T. Barber, CPA, to State Board of Certified Public Accountant (CPA) Examiners

Raleigh – Governor Michael F. Easley has appointed Jeffrey T. Barber, CPA, of Raleigh, to the State Board of CPA Examiners for a three-year term expiring June 30, 2010.

Barber, who was licensed as a North Carolina CPA in 1990, has served as the managing partner of the Raleigh office of PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP, for the past 14 years. He has been with that firm more than 30 years and has been a partner for more than 19 years.

A member of the North Carolina Association of CPAs (NCACPA) and the American Institute of CPAs (AICPA), Barber is a former member of the UNC-CH Accounting Advisory Board and the NCSU College of Management Advisory Board.

Barber is a member of the Board of Directors and a past chair of the Council for Entrepreneurial Development (CED). In 2000, he received the CED's Outstanding Service Award. In 2006, the North Carolina Technology Association (NCTA) awarded him its "Volunteer of the Year" award in honor of his years of service as NCTA treasurer.

Barber is currently serving on the Board of Directors of the North Carolina Museum of Art Foundation and the Board of Directors of the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation. He is a past president of Artspace, Inc.; a past president of Community Learning Center, Inc.; a former member of the Greater Raleigh Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors; and a former member of the United Arts Council Board of Directors.

Barber holds a B.S. in Accounting from the University of Kentucky and is a graduate of the Leadership Raleigh and Leadership Lexington (KY) training programs.

Established by Chapter 93 of the North Carolina General Statutes, the State Board of CPA Examiners is an occupational licensing board that grants certificates of qualification as certified public accountants (CPAs) to those individuals who meet the legal requirements. The Board also adopts and enforces the rules of professional ethics and conduct to be observed by CPAs in this State.
