Arthur M. Winstead, Jr., CPA, Appointed to State Board of CPA Examiners

RALEIGH - Governor Roy Cooper has appointed Arthur M. Winstead, Jr., CPA, of Greensboro to a three-year term on the State Board of CPA Examiners. He previously served on the Board 2003-2009.

Licensed as a North Carolina CPA in 1980, Winstead joined Davenport, Marvin, Joyce and Co., LLP (now DMJ & Co., PLLC), in 1978 and became a partner in 1984. He is a general services partner in the firm's Greensboro office and is the firm-wide Accounting, Auditing, and Quality Control Partner. He consults and testifies as an expert witness on accounting, auditing, and financial matters. He is the author of numerous continuing professional (CPE) courses and teaches ethics, accounting, and auditing CPE courses nationwide.

A member of the American Institute of CPAs (AICPA) and the North Carolina Association of CPAs (NCACPA), Winstead is a member of the NCACPA Accounting & Attestation and Peer Review Committees and is a past member of the NCACPA Board of Directors. He served a three-year term on the AICPA Auditing Standards Board.

Winstead is active in numerous local, state, and national civic organizations. He is Chair of the UNC-G Excellence Foundation and is a past member of the UNC-G Bryan School of Business Advisory Board and the UNC-G Board of Visitors. He is a member of the Greensboro Sports Council and the City of Greensboro Human Services Commission, and has been involved with the American Cancer Society, the Greensboro Transit Authority, Greenhill Center for NC Art, and Starmount Forest Country Club.

Winstead is a life member and past president of the Greensboro Jaycees. He currently serves on the Executive Committee of the Old North State Council of Boy Scouts. He is a past chair of the Greensboro Coliseum Commission and is a past member of the Piedmont/Triad Juvenile Diabetes Foundation Board of Directors. He is a member of the Guilford County Democratic Party, where he previously served as president and treasurer.

Established by Chapter 93 of the North Carolina General Statutes, the State Board of CPA Examiners is the occupational licensing board that grants certificates of qualification as CPAs to those individuals who meet the statutory requirements. The Board is composed of seven members appointed by the Governor. North Carolina has more than 21,000 CPAs with active licenses.
