STATE BOARD OF CPA EXAMINERS ELECTS 2020-2021 OFFICERS

RALEIGH -- The North Carolina State Board of Certified Public Accountant (CPA) Examiners has elected officers for the 2020-2021 fiscal year that began April 1, 2020.

Michael S. Massey, CPA, of Morrisville, was elected President; Barton W. Baldwin, CPA, of Mount Olive, was elected Vice President; and Gary R. Massey, CPA, of Emerald Isle, was elected Secretary-Treasurer.

Appointed to the Board in 2018, Michael S. Massey has held a North Carolina CPA license since 2009. He is Senior Vice President of Product Strategy at Georgia's Own Credit Union.

Barton W. Baldwin, a North Carolina CPA since 1978, was appointed to the Board in 2019. He previously served on the Board 1994-2003 and 2010-2014. He is Managing Partner of Baldwin & Hodge, LLP.

Licensed as a North Carolina CPA in 1980, Gary R. Massey was appointed to the Board in 2018. He is Director (Triangle) at CliftonLarsonAllen, LLP, and is Senior Advisor, Healthcare Policy and Finance with Cansler Collaborative Resources, Inc.

About the Board

Established by Chapter 93 of the North Carolina General Statutes, the State Board of CPA Examiners is an occupational licensing board that grants certificates of qualification as CPAs to those individuals who meet the statutory requirements. The Board also adopts and enforces the rules of professional ethics and conduct to be observed by CPAs in North Carolina. An independent State agency, the Board is composed of seven members appointed by the Governor. Five members must be holders of valid and unrevoked NC CPA certificates as issued by the Board. The remaining two members, who are not CPAs, represent the interests of the public-at-large. North Carolina. As of April 3, 2020, North Carolina has 22,176 CPAs with active licenses.
