S. LYNNE SANDERS, CPA, JOINS CPA BOARD STAFF AS DEPUTY DIRECTOR

RALEIGH--The North Carolina State Board of Certified Public Accountant (CPA) Examiners is pleased to announce that S. Lynne Sanders, CPA, has joined the Board staff as Deputy Director.

Sanders' extensive accounting experience includes 12 years with the UNC System Office. As the Vice President for Compliance and Audit Services, Sanders was the Chief Audit Officer for the System Office and worked with System institutions on audit, compliance, and enterprise risk management-related matters. Before her employment with the UNC System Office, Sanders spent 21 years with the Office of the State Auditor, where she performed and managed financial and compliance audits.

Licensed as a North Carolina CPA in 1992, Sanders graduated from North Carolina State University with a BA in Accounting.

About the Board

Established by Chapter 93 of the North Carolina General Statutes, the State Board of CPA Examiners is an occupational licensing board that grants certificates of qualification as CPAs to those individuals who meet the statutory requirements. The Board also adopts and enforces the rules of professional ethics and conduct to be observed by CPAs in North Carolina. Members of the Board are appointed by the Governor and serve three-year terms. Five members must be holders of valid and unrevoked NC CPA certificates issued by the Board in accordance with the NC General Statutes. The remaining two members, who are not CPAs, represent the interests of the public at large.
