33 NORTH CAROLINA CANDIDATES PASS UNIFORM CPA EXAMINATION

Raleigh—The North Carolina State Board of Certified Public Accountant (CPA) Examiners is pleased to announce that 33 North Carolina candidates passed the Uniform CPA Examination in January 2023.

The Uniform CPA Examination consists of four sections: Auditing and Attestation (AUD), Business Environment and Concepts (BEC), Financial Accounting and Reporting (FAR), and Regulation (REG). These four sections represent a total of 16 hours of testing. The Uniform CPA Examination assures that those who pass the CPA Examination have the technical knowledge and the skills necessary for CPA licensure.

The successful Exam candidates must now meet the State's education, work experience, and moral character requirements to become licensed as North Carolina CPAs.
