- **D. Michael (Mickey) Payseur, CPA**

Appointed by Governor Roy Cooper in 2022, Mr. Payseur is the Board's current Secretary-Treasurer and Chair of the Investment Committee. He also serves on the Executive Committee, Professional Standards Committee, and Personnel Committee, and has previously served on the Professional Application & Education Committee and the Strategy Committee. In addition to his Board duties, Mr. Payseur is a member of both the NCACPA and the AICPA.
