New User Portal Offers Expanded Online Services

On April 13, 2026, the Board launched a new user [portal](#) to streamline Exam and license applications, CPA certificate and firm registration renewals, and updates to personal information.

The upgraded system improves efficiency, strengthens data security, and expands self-service options for licensees, candidates, applicants, and CPA firms.

Users have several options to access the portal:

- Visit the Board's [homepage](#) and select "Access User Portal" from the *I Want To* menu, or
- Use the direct link: <https://ncboav7prod.glsuite.us/ui/licensee/login/Login>, or
- Navigate to the main menu page by clicking the hamburger menu icon (the three lines to the right of the "I Am A" menu at the top of the [homepage](#)) and selecting Access User Portal at the bottom of the page.

The portal allows users to complete a wide range of tasks in one place, including submitting initial and re-exam applications, applying for original or reciprocal licensure, requesting name changes, completing certificate reinstatement applications, and renewing CPA certificates and firm registrations.

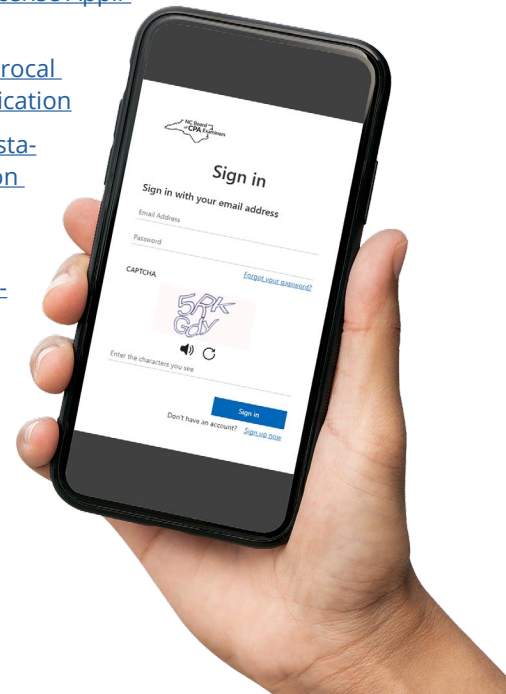
All users must create login credentials (see page 3) to access the portal, apply for the Exam or licensure, manage records, and complete renewals. This is especially important as the 2026-2027 CPA certificate renewal period is now open (see page 2).

The portal includes enhanced security features, such as two-factor authentication, and a Communication Center that centralizes updates, reminders, and important notifications.

To support users, step-by-step video tutorials and application checklists (see list at right) are available for most processes, highlighting key steps and helping ensure submissions are accurate and complete. The Board recommends reviewing these materials before accessing the portal the first time.

2026–2027 NC CPA Certificate Renewal Guide

The 2026–2027 North Carolina CPA certificate renewal period is now open. All CPAs with active or CPA-retired status must complete the renewal through the Board's new [user portal](#), or [request inactive status](#) by June 30, 2026.

Accessing the New Portal

To access the portal:

- Visit the Board's homepage and select "Access User Portal" from the *I Want To* menu, or
- Use the direct link: <https://ncboav7prod.glsuite.us/ui/licensee/login/Login>, or
- Navigate to the main menu page by clicking the hamburger menu icon (the three lines to the right of the *I Am A* menu at the top of the [homepage](#)) and selecting Access User Portal at the bottom of the page.

Important: All users must create new login credentials. Usernames and passwords from the previous portal will not work.

You can set up your login in one of two ways:

- Sign in using your Google, Apple, Microsoft, or LinkedIn account, or
- Select "Sign Up Now" to create a username and password

If you create a username and password, you must complete CAPTCHA prompts and verify your email and phone number.

Getting Started with Your Renewal

Once logged in:

- Go to your Dashboard
- Select "CPA Renewals" from the left-hand menu
- Click "Continue" on the Manage Renewals page

What to Expect During Renewal

While the portal has a new look, the renewal process itself will feel familiar. You must:

- Review and update your personal information
- Answer moral character questions and upload documentation for any "Yes" responses
- Provide employment and professional affiliation updates
- Answer CPE compliance questions, if required
- Affirm compliance with the Employee Fair Classification Act (EFCA)
- Attest to your understanding of North Carolina accountancy laws and rules
- Pay the \$60 renewal fee

CPE Reporting Requirements

- **Active CPAs:** Must report 2025 CPE, including the required 50-minute ethics course from a NASBA-approved sponsor
- **Licensed on or after January 1, 2026:** No CPE reporting required
- **Retired CPAs:** No CPE reporting required
- **Non-resident CPAs:** Must confirm compliance with NC requirements or another jurisdiction

Completing Your Renewal

After all sections are complete, you will be prompted to submit payment by MasterCard, Visa, or American Express. To avoid duplicate charges, please allow at least 30 seconds for the transaction to be processed, and do not click "Authorize Payment" more than once.

If you are unable to proceed to payment:

- Check the Requirements section for any incomplete items
- Ensure all required supporting documents have been uploaded
- Confirm all check boxes and attestations are completed

Once payment is submitted:

- You may print a receipt for your records
- A confirmation notice will be available in your Communication Center
- Your license will be valid through June 30, 2027

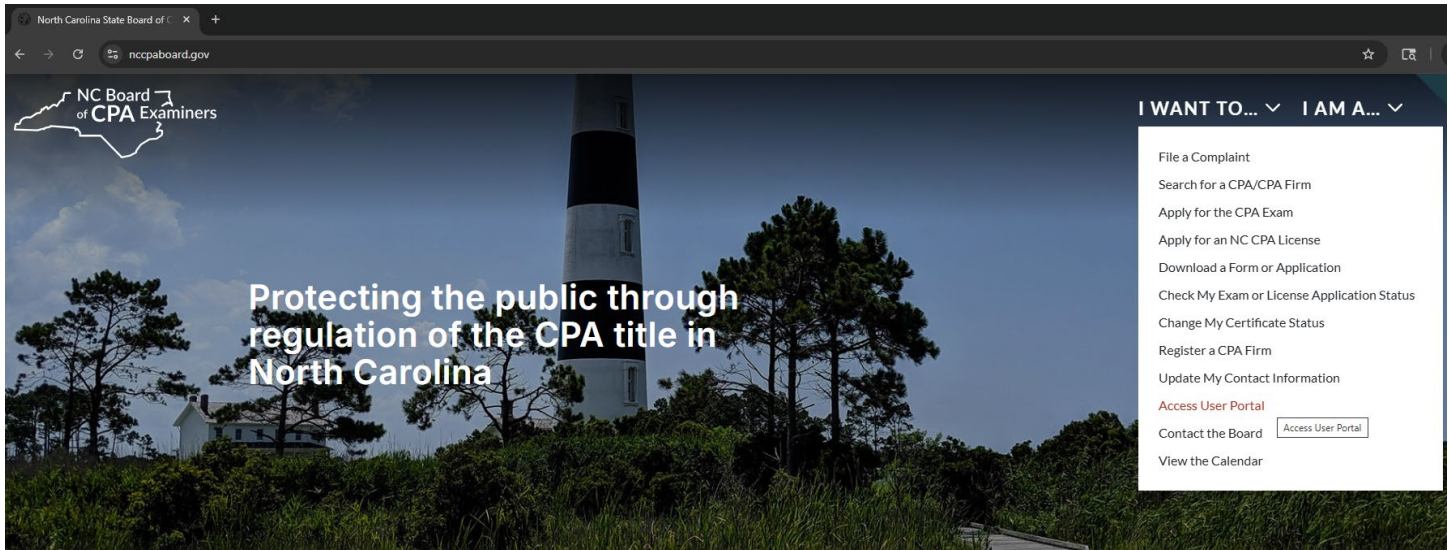
Considering CPA-retired Status?

A [request for CPA-retired status](#) submitted during the renewal period must be approved before the certificate renewal can be completed. Status changes are not automatic and require submission of the appropriate application and attestations.

Because certificate renewal requirements vary by status, Board staff must first process the request for retired status to ensure the correct requirements are applied to your record.

Getting Started with the User Portal



Q. How do I access the user portal?

A. You can access the portal in several ways, including:

- Visit the Board's homepage and select "Access User Portal" from the I Want To menu at the top of the page, or
- Use the direct link: <https://ncboav7prod.glsuite.us/ui/licensee/login>, or
- Navigate to the main menu page by clicking the hamburger menu icon (the three lines to the right of the I Am A menu at the top of the [homepage](#)) and select "Access User Portal" at the bottom of the page.

Q. Is it safe to sign in using my Google, Apple, Microsoft, or LinkedIn account?

A. Yes. Signing in with Google, Apple, Microsoft, or LinkedIn is a secure and widely used method for accessing online services. These platforms use advanced security features, such as encryption and multi-factor authentication, to help protect your information.

- When you choose this option, the Board does not see or store your password for those accounts. Instead, the provider securely handles sign-in, verifies your identity, and grants you access to the portal.

- Using one of these sign-in options is often the quickest and easiest way to create and access your account, while still maintaining a high level of security.

Q. Why does the portal require CAPTCHA codes and email or text verifications?

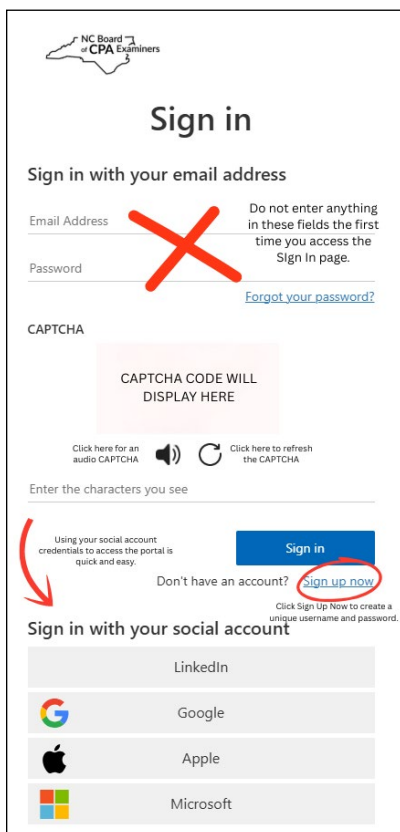
A. These security measures help protect your personal and professional information. The portal uses:

- Two-factor authentication (2FA): Adds an extra layer of security by requiring a second verification step such as a code sent to your cell phone. If you do not want to receive a verification by text, please select "Call Me."
- CAPTCHA: Helps distinguish real users from automated programs, preventing unauthorized access and fraudulent activity

These safeguards follow widely accepted national cybersecurity standards and are commonly used by state and federal agencies to protect sensitive information.

Q. The CAPTCHA is difficult to read. I entered what I thought it was, but it was incorrect. Do I need to start over?

A. No. If the CAPTCHA is difficult to read, click the refresh icon below it to generate a new one. You can refresh it as many times as needed until you receive a CAPTCHA that is easier to read. You can also receive an audio code by clicking on the speaker icon.



Q. I'm on the Sign In page and entered the username and password I used last year, but it isn't working.

A. Your login from the previous portal will not work in the new system. Entering your credentials from the old portal will result in an error message.

All users must create new login credentials to access the new portal. To get started:

- Sign in using your Google, Apple, Microsoft, or LinkedIn credentials (a quick and easy option), or
- Select "Sign Up Now" under the Sign In section to create a new username and password.

Q. Why don't I see the email verification in my inbox?

A. It may take several minutes to arrive. The email verification code is sent from Microsoft with the subject line "Microsoft on Behalf of North Carolina Board of CPA Examiners." Make sure you check your spam or junk email folder for the message.

Q. I tried to create a username and password, but I received a message that my account wasn't found. What should I do?

A. This message typically means the information entered in the Option 1 fields doesn't exactly match what the Board has on file. Even small differences can prevent a match.

Common issues include:

- Using a different email address than the one in your mailing address with the Board
- A name change that hasn't been updated with the Board
- Typographical errors or slight variations in spelling

Please double-check your information and try again. If the information is correct, delete the information and reenter it. If correcting or re-entering the information does not allow you to link to your record, please contact the Board at (919) 733-4222.

Q. I set up a new username and password, but now I can't remember the password. How do I get a new password?

A. You can reset your password by clicking the Forgot Password? link on the Sign In page. Unlike the old portal, the new portal does not allow Board staff to reset your password or provide a temporary password.

Q. I'm on a page that has an Option 1 section and an Option 2 section. Which one should I choose?

A. Choose the option that best matches your history with the Board:

- Option 1: For individuals who already have a record with the Board. This includes anyone who has ever applied for the CPA Exam, applied for licensure, or currently holds (or previously held) a North Carolina CPA license

Option 1:

Option 1 is ONLY for individuals who already have a record with the North Carolina State Board of Certified Public Accountant Examiners, including current North Carolina CPA licensees and those who have previously submitted a CPA Exam or CPA licensure application to the Board. If you have never submitted a CPA Exam or CPA licensure application to the Board, you must use Option 2.

- Option 2: For individuals who have no prior history with the Board and have never submitted a CPA Exam or licensure application.

Option 2:

Option 2 is ONLY for individuals who have never submitted a CPA Exam or CPA licensure application to the North Carolina State Board of Certified Public Accountant Examiners and have no record with the Board. If you currently hold a North Carolina CPA license or have previously submitted a CPA Exam or CPA licensure application to the Board, you must use Option 1.

If you already have an existing record with the Board and complete Option 2 instead of Option 1, a duplicate record is created. This duplication can lead to processing issues and delays in reviewing and completing your renewal or application.

Q. If I previously applied for the CPA Exam but have never used the portal, which option should I select?

A. You should select Option 1. Because you've applied to the Board in the past, you already have a record with the Board, even if this is your first time using the portal.

Apply for the CPA Exam and Licensure in the Portal

The Board's [online portal](#) makes it easier than ever to take the next step in your CPA journey. Whether you're preparing to [sit for the CPA Exam](#) or ready to [apply for CPA licensure](#), you can now complete the entire process in one place.

To help you navigate the process, [tutorials](#) on accessing the portal, creating your login credentials, and applying through the portal are available. [Checklists](#) are also available to help you gather the information and documentation you will need to enter into the application or upload to the portal.

The system is designed to guide you along the way, helping reduce delays and ensuring you know exactly what information is needed to move your application forward. Instead of managing paperwork across multiple channels, everything is centralized and available whenever you need it.

Whether you're beginning or continuing your path to CPA licensure, the portal is your starting point. Visit the [Board's website](#), then select "Access User Portal" from the I Want To menu at the top of the page to create your account and get started.

Navigating Your Dashboard

After you link to or create your portal account, you'll be directed to your personal dashboard. On the dashboard homepage, you'll find a list of helpful tutorial videos and application checklists and an Overview menu. The options available in the Overview menu will differ based on your history with the Board.

User with No History with the Board (Option 2 on the Options Screen)

A new user will not initially see "Exam Applications" or "CPA Applications" in the Overview menu. These options will only be available after the user has fully completed all required Personal Information fields.

In Memoriam: William Edward Self

William (Bill) Edward Self, 90, a former member of the State Board of CPA Examiners, died on October 29, 2025.

A 1957 graduate of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, he was licensed as a North Carolina CPA in 1962 and was the owner of Self and Associates in Durham.

Governor James G. Martin appointed Mr. Self to the Board in 1983. He was elected Secretary-Treasurer in 1984 and Vice President in 1985.

In addition to his executive leadership roles, he served on several committees, including the Application & Enforcement Committee and a joint committee with the NCACPA focused on increasing licensees' awareness of the Board's ethics rules.

In 2013, during the Board's 100th anniversary, he was recognized for his service to the Board and the profession.

Mr. Self was president of the NC Association of CPAs, a long-time North Carolina ethics instructor, and an active member of Duke Memorial United Methodist Church.

He served as Chair of the Board of Durham County General Hospital, Chair of the UNC Chapel Hill Nursing School Foundation, and a member of the Board of Directors of the Durham Library Foundation.
