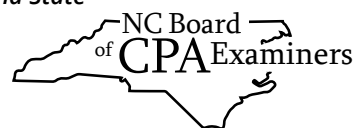

# Renew Your CPA License by June 30, 2026

June 30, 2026, is the deadline to renew North Carolina CPA certificate for the 2026–2027 license year or [request inactive status](#).

All renewals must be completed through the Board's new online portal. Because this is a new system, all users must create an account with new login credentials.

When accessing the [portal](#) for the first time, do not enter anything in the Sign In fields. Instead, choose one of the following options:

- Sign in with your Google, Apple, LinkedIn, or Microsoft account, or
- Click "Sign Up Now" below the Sign In fields to create a username and password.

After creating your account, you must verify your record by selecting Option 1 and entering your name and email address exactly as they appear in the Board's records. Use the email address where you received the *Activity Review*.



If you do not plan to maintain your certificate, you must [request inactive status](#) by June 30. If you wish to renew as a CPA-Retired certificate holder, you must [submit an application](#) and receive approval before completing the renewal.

## Board Rules Updated

North Carolina law requires all administrative rules to be reviewed and re-adopted every 10 years. The Board recently completed that process, updating and clarifying numerous rules to reflect statutory changes, current professional practices, and the evolving needs of applicants, licensees, and CPA firms. Below is a summary of some of the changes.

### Administrative and Statutory Updates

Many revisions were administrative in nature and focused on aligning Board rules with current North Carolina statutes. The Board also added a definition of good moral character and clarified related forms and documentation requirements to provide greater guidance for applicants navigating the licensure process.

### New Licensure Pathway Reflected in the Rules

One of the most significant changes affects individuals seeking CPA licensure. The Board removed references to the 150-semester-hour education requirement, aligning the rules with recent statutory changes that created an additional pathway to CPA licensure.

### CPE Reporting Clarified

The revised rules clarify that licensees may claim CPE credit only once for the same course during a single reporting cycle. If a course is taken multiple times within the same cycle, credit may be reported for only one completion.

### Independence Rules Streamlined

Several amendments were made to the Board's independence rules to make them easier for licensees and firms to understand and apply. These revisions also bring the rules into closer alignment with current professional standards.

### ESOP Ownership Framework Added

The updated rules establish a framework that may allow Employee Stock Ownership Plan (ESOP) ownership interests in CPA firms, provided all applicable ownership and regulatory requirements are met.

### CPA Examination Rules Modernized

The Board also updated and streamlined several CPA Examination-related rules to better reflect current examination administration processes and the Board's relationships with examination vendors.

These updates are intended to improve clarity, enhance consistency, and ensure the Board's regulatory framework remains responsive to the profession while continuing to protect the public interest.

# Having Trouble Accessing the Portal?

## The Two Most Common Mistakes Users Make

As the June 30 certificate renewal deadline approaches, and more applicants are using the portal, Board staff are assisting many users with questions about portal access. The good news is that most issues can be resolved quickly, and stem from the same two mistakes.

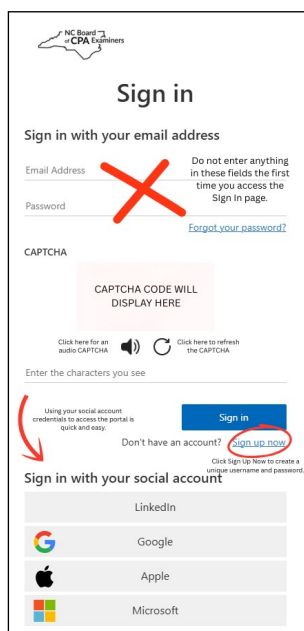
### Mistake #1: Trying to Sign in Before Creating an Account

The Board's [portal](#) is a new system. Login credentials from the previous portal were not transferred and will not work.

Every user who has not created a new account since April 13, 2026, must create an account before accessing renewal information.

The first time you access the [portal home page](#), do not enter an email address or password in the Sign In section. Instead, either:

- Sign in using your Google, Apple, LinkedIn, or Microsoft account, or



- Click "Sign Up Now" below the Sign In section to create a username and password.

### Mistake #2: Completing the Incorrect Option Fields

When you reach the Options page, choose the option that best matches your history with the Board:

- **Option 1:** For individuals who already have a record with the Board. This includes anyone who has ever applied for the CPA Exam, applied for licensure, or currently holds (or previously held) a North Carolina CPA license
- **Option 2:** For individuals who have no prior history with the Board and have never submitted a CPA Exam or licensure application.

Option 1 account-matching issues arise when users enter information that differs from their existing Board record. Common examples include using a different email address, entering a full name instead of an initial (or vice versa), using a nickname, or using a last name that differs from the one on file with the Board.

## Why Use a Social Account as Your Portal Sign In?

Many users have told the Board that using a social account is the quickest and easiest way to establish their portal account and create login credentials.

Using a social account allows you to sign in with credentials you already use and trust, such as Google, Apple, Microsoft, or LinkedIn.

Instead of creating and remembering another username and password, you can use an existing social account to access the portal quickly and securely.

### Benefits

- Faster setup: Create your account in just a few clicks.
- No new password to remember: Use credentials you already have.
- Secure authentication: Your identity is verified by your chosen provider.
- Less hassle: Avoid password resets and account recovery issues.

### How It Works

1. On the [portal home page](#), instead of clicking "Sign Up Now" below the Sign In section, select Google, Apple, Microsoft, or LinkedIn in the Sign In with Your Social Account list.
2. Sign in to your social account.

3. Review and accept any permissions requested.
4. Return to the portal and complete Option 1 (for users who already have a history with the Board) or Option 2 (for users who have no history with the Board).
5. Once your identity is verified or created, you can access your dashboard.

# NC Candidate Receives Elijah Watt Sells Award

Lauren Dever, a North Carolina CPA Exam candidate, has been named a recipient of the 2025 Elijah Watt Sells Award, one of the accounting profession's highest honors for CPA Exam performance.

Ms. Dever was one of only six CPA Exam candidates to earn the award in 2025. More than 87,000 individuals sat for the CPA Exam last year.

Presented by the AICPA and NASBA, the Elijah Watt Sells Award recognizes candidates who achieve exceptional scores on the Uniform CPA Examination.

To qualify, candidates must earn a cumulative average score above 95.50 across the Exam's three Core sections and one

Discipline section, pass all four sections on their first attempt, and complete testing during the calendar year.

Any failed section attempt disqualifies a candidate from consideration.

Ms. Dever earned a Bachelor of Arts in International Business and Management from Dickinson College and a Master of Accounting from UNC Kenan-Flagler.

The Board congratulates Ms. Dever on this exceptional accomplishment and is proud to recognize her as one of the nation's top CPA Exam candidates.

### Q: Who sets the CPA Exam fees?

A: The CPA Exam fees are set by the three CPA Exam partners: NASBA, AICPA, and Prometric. These fees are based on contractual agreements among the partners and are subject to periodic increases.

Each jurisdiction's board of accountancy sets its own administrative or application fee. North Carolina's administrative fees have not changed in many years.

### Q: Where does the money go?

A: In North Carolina, candidates pay both the administrative and section fees to the Board in one payment. Here's how the payment is allocated:

The Board keeps the administrative fee (\$230 or \$75) to cover background checks, application review, and processing.

The section fees are sent to the CPA Exam partners by the Board. The Board does not retain any portion of these fees.

# Applying for the Exam or a CPA License Using the Portal

In April 2026, the Board launched a [new online application system and user portal](#). Before you can apply for the [CPA Exam](#) or a [CPA license](#), you must create a new portal account the first time you access the system. Follow the steps below to get started.

## Step 1: Create Your Portal Account

When you [first visit the portal](#), do not enter anything in the Sign In fields.

Instead, choose one of the following options:

- Sign in using your Google, Apple, LinkedIn, or Microsoft account; or
- Click "Sign Up Now" to create a username and password.

For additional help creating your account, refer to the article "Having Trouble Accessing the Portal?" on page 3 or visit the [Board's website](#) for detailed instructions.

Once your account has been created, you will be taken to the Options page.

## Step 2: Tell Us Whether You Have Applied Before

The option you choose depends on whether you have previously applied to the Board.

### Option 1: You Have Applied Before

Choose this option if you have previously submitted a CPA Exam application or a CPA license application to the Board.

To connect your new portal account to your existing Board record:

1. Enter the same name and email address currently on file with the Board.
2. If you are unsure which email address to use, enter the email address where you received the most recent *Activity Review*.

Once your record is successfully linked, you will be taken to your dashboard. Application options will display in the Overview Menu.

If you do not see the application options:

- Review your personal information for missing or incorrect information.
- Update any incomplete fields.
- If you have a business address, make sure it has been entered.

### Option 2: You Have Never Applied Before

Choose this option if you have never submitted a CPA Exam application or a CPA license application to the Board.

You will create a new record using your full legal name exactly as it appears on your government-issued identification.

After you reach your dashboard, complete all required Personal Information fields. Application options will not display until this information is complete.

## Step 3: Complete Your Personal Information

Whether you are linking an existing record or creating a new one, you may need to review, update, or complete your personal information.

Be sure to complete all required fields. Until the Personal Information section is complete, application options will not display in the Overview Menu.

## Step 4: Select the Application You Need

After completing your personal information, select the appropriate application category from the Overview Menu.

Select Exam Applications if you are:

- Applying to take the CPA Exam for the first time, or
- Applying for a re-examination section.

Select CPA Applications if you are:

- Applying for an original CPA license, or
- Applying for a reciprocal CPA license.

## Step 5: Review the Application Checklist

Before starting your application, review the checklist for your application type.

The Exam and Licensing landing pages contain links to the appropriate checklists, including:

- [Original License Applications](#)
- [Reciprocal License Applications](#)

Reviewing the checklist before you begin can help ensure you have all the required information and documentation ready, which may help prevent delays in processing your application.

## Step 6: Complete the Application

Carefully complete each section of the application. Some sections may require additional information, explanations, or supporting documentation.

Before submitting your application, be sure to:

- Complete all required fields.
- Upload all required supporting documents.
- Review each section for accuracy and completeness.
- Read all attestations carefully.
- Check all required boxes and provide any required initials or acknowledgments.
- Submit any required application fees.

The portal will indicate whether the required information is missing. You have 120 days after starting an application to complete it and pay the fee. Applications that are incomplete or missing required documentation cannot be processed and may result in delays.
